REGISTER NOW FOR 2021-2022

EARLY LEARNING
If your child is 3 years or before September 1, they are eligible to be enrolled in Early Learning. Funding is available for children who are working towards a primary program or start full-time in a Kindergarten class.

KINDERGARTEN
If your child is 5 or older before December 31, it is time to register for Kindergarten.

Registration forms are available online at horizon.ab.ca or at your neighbourhood school. Bring your child's Birth Certificate or Canadian Citizenship status card and Alberta Health Care card.
