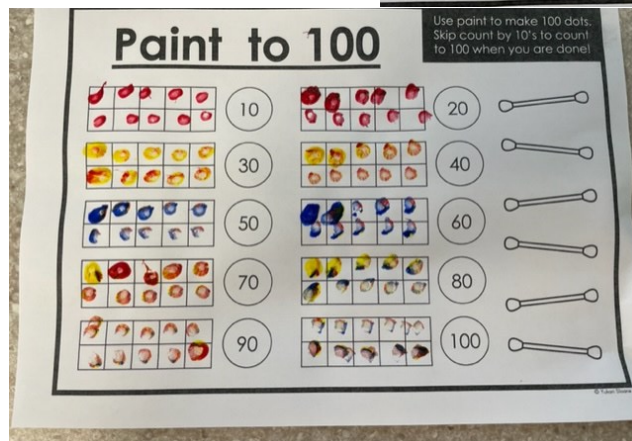
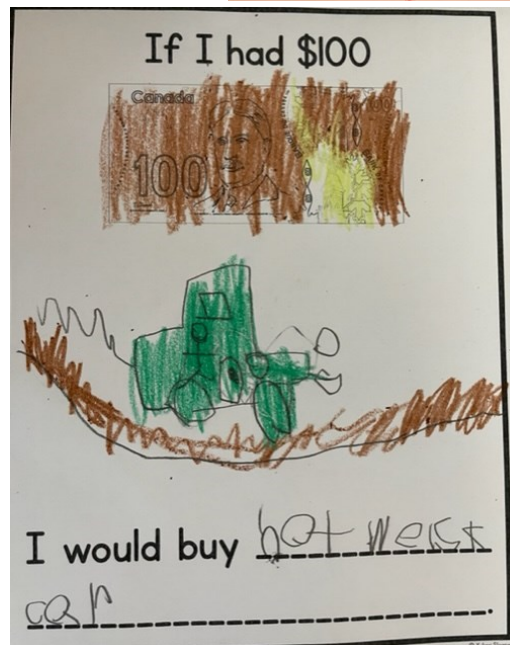
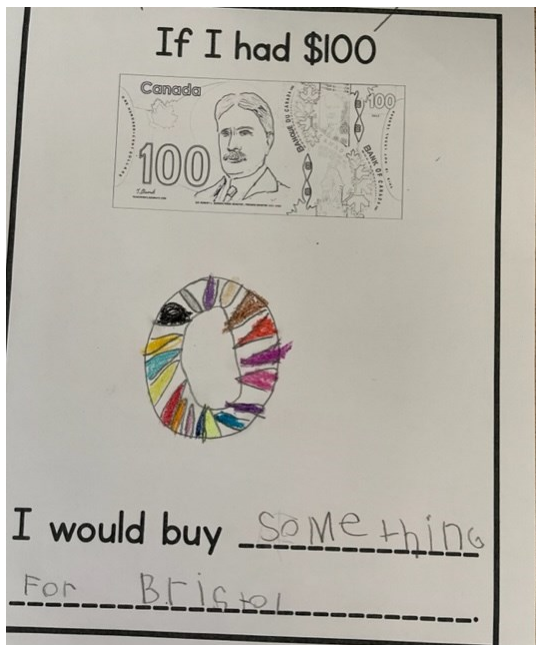
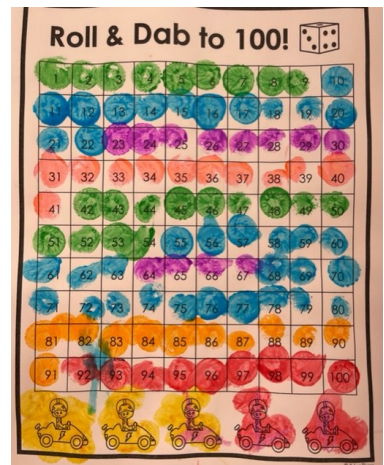
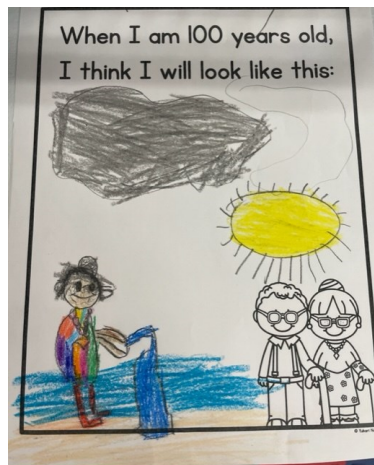
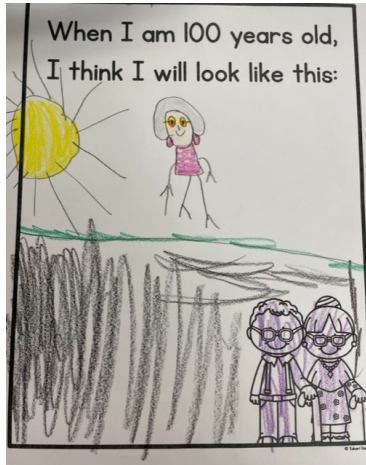
**Archery:** Archery is in full swing with Provincials March 17th-20th, 2022 in Edmonton. We have 9 students participating... Good luck students and have fun!

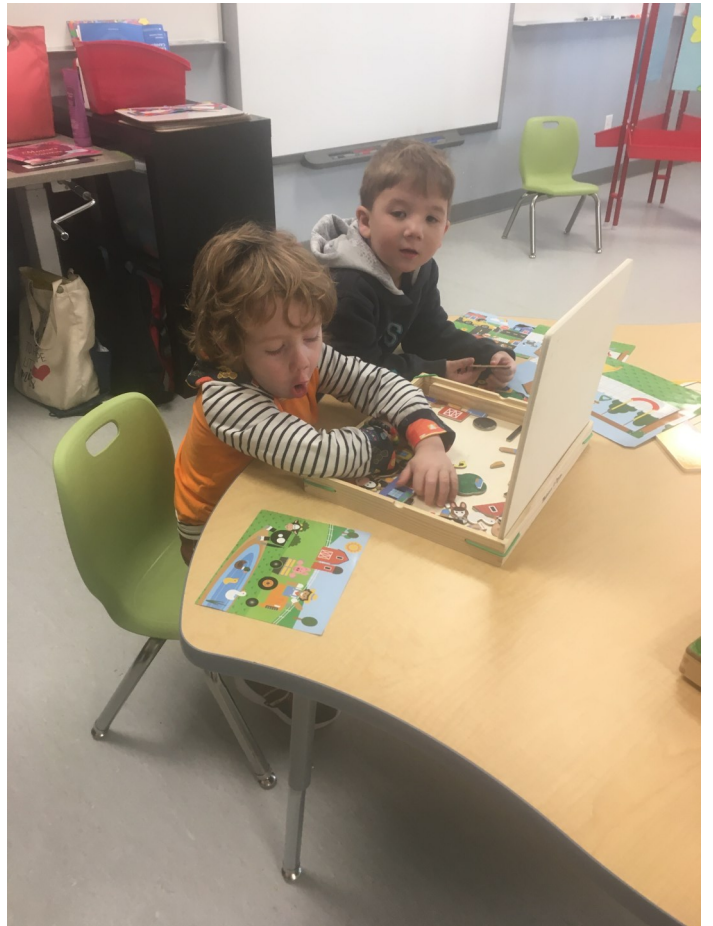
**No School:** There will be NO SCHOOL on Friday, March 4th, Monday, March 7th and Friday, March 25th.

# School News

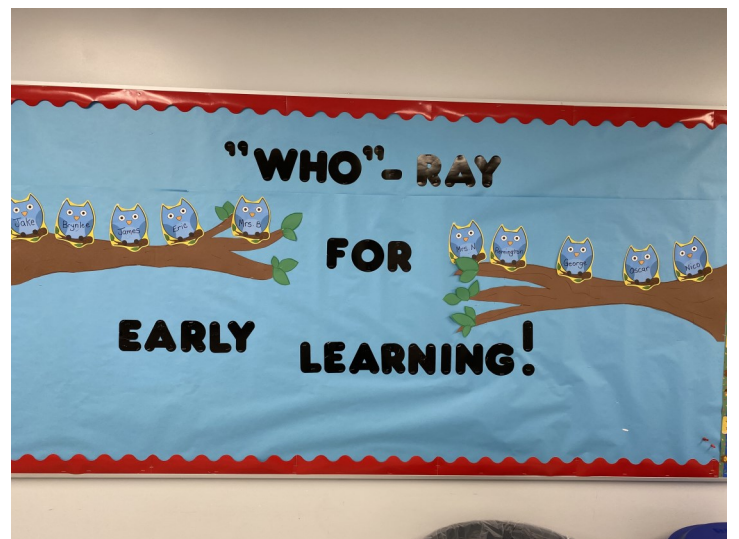

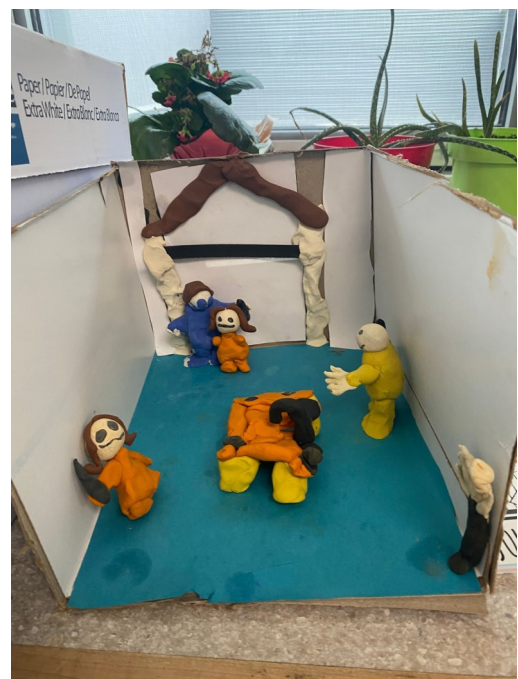
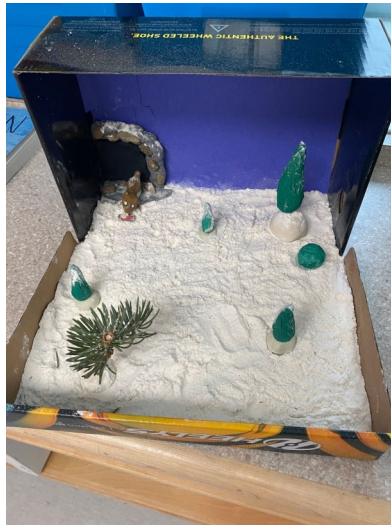
