**Library:** All library books will be due by Wednesday June 1st, after June 1st library books will not be allowed to be taken home for the rest of the school year. Thank You.







Our gardening and school beautification group has been hard at work caring for a variety of plants in the greenhouse and filling new planter boxes. We are very proud of and appreciate their hard work!




### Workout CTF



The grade 9 class has been exploring scale factor in a recent unit. Students created scale drawings based on a small image by applying their understanding of scale factor.






