



Hello everyone!

It is that time of year again skating, and hockey is just around the corner. There are a few minor changes/ updates mentioned below. As always if you have any questions feel free to DM.

- 1) We are offering a Learn-to-Power Skate level this year. This will focus on the key skating elements (stride, coordination, balance) to creating stronger hockey players. This level will be ideal for kids who are already enrolled in a hockey program or kids that have a skating foundation and interested in playing hockey. We encourage kids to wear their full gear if they wish and to bring their sticks.
- 2) We will be doing a skills show case on December 9th. This will be similar to those who have participated in a skating carnival, but less coordination and more about their individual skills. The plan after the showcase is to have a Christmas Party/Skate. More details to follow!
- 3) We are hoping lessons can begin the week of October 19th, but this will depend on ice.
- 4) This year we are going to try an 8-week session and as of right now we do NOT plan to host a session in the New Year. However, things change and if the interest is high the coaches may reassess later in the year.

Lessons will be on Thursdays again from 445(ish) to 6:15

For the 8 week session the cost will be 100/skater. We hope to see you all back this year!! Please have registration forms in by September 30th. This will help with getting the schedule out a couple weeks before skating lessons so parents and coaches can prepare.
