Staffing

All three athletes performed well, with **Isaac taking first in javelin**, qualifying him for provincials in Calgary on June 6–7. We wish him the best of luck!

Warner students again excelled—Jacey Cronkhite placed first in the girls' 100m and 200m, Avery Pittman placed first in hurdles, and Sam Miller placed second in high jump. Report Cards: Report Cards will be mailed out June 26,2025 and will contain next school years supply lists.


